**SERVICE DOG FEE WAIVER AFFIDAVIT**

For the purpose of pet license fee waiver, a service dog is one that is specifically trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual in the household with a disability. The task(s) performed by a service dog must be directly related to the handler's disability. The provision of emotional support, well-being, depression relief, protection, or companionship DO NOT constitute work or tasks for the purposes of this definition.

**To qualify for the pet license fee waiver, you must truthfully answer the following questions and sign below.**

Is the dog a service dog, and required due to a disability?  
What work or task has the dog been trained to perform?

I have read and understand the above definitions of 'disability' and of 'service dog'. I further understand that it is against the law to misrepresent my need for a service animal. The dog in question meets the requirements for fee waiver.
