A DEEP DEDICATION TO SAVING LIVES

A Message from Executive Director Eric Stevens and Board President David Sanders

All of us involved with Kitsap Humane Society share a deep commitment to saving animals' lives. And through that collective dedication, our mission thrived in 2016. We saved many more lives than ever before (6,391 pets rehomed), and achieved our highest save rate (96%) ever. Due to a rising need, we took in more animals from our local Kitsap community, and returned 18% more lost pets to their owners than the year before. Our Rescue Me program, which brings in animals from partner shelters, grew by 38%. Customers from all over the region flocked to KHS, adopting 5,594 animals (up 60% in three years). We are deeply grateful for our community's support and trust.

It Takes a Village (and Individualized Care) to Save an Animal

Numbers do not begin to convey the many individualized and specialized ways we have enhanced the care and treatment for the animals in our midst: The personalized, loving handling of each of the 2,219 animals arriving from partner shelters. The individualized care given by foster families to 1,107 animals. The dedication of our veterinary team members who treated a higher volume of sick or injured animals entering the shelter. The new behavior and training mindset that engages virtually every staff member and volunteer in the tailored behavior plans for those animals that need it.

KHS at a Crossroads - A New Building Needed

Going forward, our strategic vision is less about growth in volume and more about further enhancing medical, behavior and foster care programming and expanding our services out into the community, e.g. humane education for school-aged children, and more assistance to help very low-income families keep and care for their pets.

But the single biggest need is for a new shelter facility. Following a year of study and planning, our Board has voted to move forward with a capital campaign to raise funds for an enlarged and re-engineered facility that will support and further advance our progressive, lifesaving animal welfare practices. This likely will be a 3 to 4-year effort, but it's a need that we are ready to champion.



COMPASSION FOR ALL ANIMALS

Our Innovative Adoption Programs Found Homes for More Difficult-to-Place Animals Than Ever Before

All animals at KHS interface with and benefit from several of our innovative lifesaving departments, including our rescue, foster, and adoption programs. Each animal is treated as an individual - their care is triaged to help them succeed and find the right home. Our innovative adoption programs found homes for more difficult-to-place animals than ever before.

Highlights Include:

- Hospice adoptions for very old and/or terminally ill pets
- Barn cat placement for "working" cats
- Large-scale community adoption events, including 195 pets adopted during our Black Friday event with Zappos

Foster Program

This program saved a record number of orphaned kittens last year, with over 100 families providing lifesaving in-home care getting the kittens ready for adoption. A record number of puppies and adult dogs with medical and behavior issues also benefited from foster care. These animals included Rescue Me Program dogs with heartworm that had no chance of treatment or adoption in their own communities but were able to be saved through our Foster and Rescue Me Program.

Rescue Me Program

This program has transferred in thousands of adoptable animals by building lifesaving networks to save high-risk pets from all over the country. In addition to regular weekly transfers, our Rescue Me program also participated in multiple large-scale rescue operations. We were able to save 25 dogs from a flooded community in Louisiana. We also became the largest mainland rescue for animals in Kauai, saving a record number of at-risk pets from our three partners on the island.





TRANSFORMING LIVES THROUGH REHABILITATION


Expanded and Enhanced Behavioral and Medical Rehabilitation Gives More Pets a Second Chance

More Medical Care Provided in 2016

KHS's shelter medicine program is one area where "compassion in action" is always running at full speed. With significantly more animals entering the shelter than the year before, more animals needed medical treatment than ever before. In addition to spaying and neutering over 5,000 owned and shelter pets, KHS's veterinary team also performed 640 other medical surgeries to save and improve shelter pets' lives. Whether hit by a car, injured by another animal, or suffering from chronic health conditions, hundreds of animals received high-quality medical care that enabled them to find loving homes.

Some specialty surgeries included:

- Some chronic health issues treated:
- Removing abdominal obstructions caused by ingested carpet, fishing line, and toys
- * Orthopedic surgeries, including pinning fractures
- Enucleating damaged, unsalvageable eyes



- Diabetes
- Epilepsy, cerebellar hypoplasia, and other neurological conditions
- Urinary crystals and incontinence
- Inflammatory Bowel Disease
- Hypo and Hyperthyroidism

Transformative Behavior Interventions

As best practices in animal welfare evolve, KHS' Behavior and Training department has also grown and evolved. In the past year, staff and volunteers have worked together to further elevate the level of behavior rehabilitation and management employed to help the animals in our care. From providing training intervention prior to surrender, to growing our "foster to surrender" program to keep at-risk pets in homes instead of the kennel, our behavior intervention is proactive and immediate. For the animals in our care, individualized enrichment, handling, and housing means that animals are given the best chance to thrive during their stay. Even after pets leave our doors, follow-up behavior and training support is available for adopters to help with their new pet's transition at home.

On any given day at KHS you might find a dog playgroup happening in the pasture, a scared cat living in an office, or a dog learning "nose work" in the Training Center. Our behavior rehabilitation efforts result in dramatic transformation for so many shelter pets.



Thousands of Supporters Help KHS Save More Lives

We are grateful for the thousands of caring individuals who help Hundreds of volunteers partnered with our staff to make our KHS fulfill its lifesaving mission. This includes our hundreds of lifesaving success possible. Volunteers fill two shifts every single dedicated volunteers; the more than 2,000 people who turned day socializing and caring for the animals at the shelter. More out for our major fundraising events and smaller outreach events opportunities for service and participation have led to higher like Pints for Pets; the more than 2,500 individuals or families volunteer engagement than ever before. who contributed financially; and the dozens of local business and corporate partners who sponsored events.

Success at our Major Fundraising Events

Our fourth annual FORE! The Animals Golf Tournament was held at Trophy Lake golf course on Friday May 20, 2016. We had 126 golfers and 11 dogs join us for a fun, shot-gun scramble tournament. Our supporters raised almost \$20,000.

Nearly 400 supporters, along with their furry family members, joined us in Downtown Poulsbo on Saturday, July 16, 2016 for our annual PetsWALK 5K charity walk/run. Following the completion of the walk, participants enjoyed the bustling waterfront vendor fair where nearly 30 of our sponsors set up interactive booth spaces. Together we raised over \$38,123 with almost \$17,000 of that through participant fundraising.

Our 23rd Annual Animal Krackers Gala Dinner and Auction

was an amazing success! Over 400 animal lovers attended this October 1 event, bidding on unique and exciting experiences and items. Combined with totals from our online auction earlier in September, the Animal Krackers attendees raised over \$343,291 (gross).





In 2016, our Pints for Pets event attracted thousands of supporters from across Kitsap and beyond. Pints for Pets is a great way to drink beer, save animals, and feel good!

Third Consecutive Year of Record Growth – More Animals Rescued, Rehabilitated and Rehomed Than Ever Before


