A Letter from Dr. Jen & Jamie

t's a heavy lift, but it's worth it. And if you ask any one of the incredible team members or volunteers at Kitsap Humane Society, they'd tell you the same.

It's a tough slog to arrive in the early a.m. hours – every single day – to puppy kennels you've just cleaned that now have to be scrubbed again. It's exhausting to finish off a day of prepping animals for surgeries by doing laundry and mopping floors. It's taxing to see a cat that you've spent countless hours with retreat to being scared again. It's overwhelming to have every kennel full, only to learn that six more strays are coming your way. It's cold, wet, windy work to ensure that every dog gets walks and playtime and socialization in the Washington weather. And it's devastating when things don't work out the way we all hope.

But regardless of the circumstances, it's worth it – because the animals are worth it. From our care staff and vet techs to our behavior and facilities teams, our adoptions crew to our tireless volunteers and generous community, every person in our circle is doing it for the critters who can't care for themselves. And that extends to our administrative staff and board as well.

Over the past several years, the people who work behind the scenes have done a lot of heavy lifting. They lobbied the Washington state legislature to change the laws as to what kind of services humane societies could and couldn't provide. When it was finally legal for shelters like ours to provide reduced-cost veterinary care for families in need, our development team went to work raising money to build a community clinic. Our board members and community jumped in to contribute to the cause. The clinic – named the Russ and Linda Young Veterinary Lifesaving Center was opened in September of 2023 and has since conducted more than 4,000 clinic appointments and 6,000 spay/neuter surgeries.

Outside of the clinic, we raised money for and built the Big Animal Barn to accommodate livestock. We built partnerships to provide free pet and people food for those who are down on their luck. And we continue to build new programs to ensure that every pet who needs a home can have one.

Now, we're taking on a new lift, the biggest one of all: building an endowment. Over the next three years, we're going to be building a safety net for the one we already provide – a \$5 million fund that will only be touched in times of dire emergency, to ensure that the services we provide today will be available forever. This endowment will keep Kitsap Humane Society going when the going gets really tough. Natural disasters. Economic collapses. Worldwide pandemics. Our goals are lofty, but necessary to secure the future of our organization - and that of animal welfare in our community. Whatever the storm, KHS will be able to weather it and continue to serve the people and pets of Kitsap.

It's going to be another heavy lift, but like every one of them before it, it'll be worth every second.

'AN INCREDIBLY FULFILLING EXPERIENCE' JOIN OUR FOSTER ROSTER

Honestly, we just wanted to make a positive impact and feel like we were truly making a difference in the community we live in."

Kitsap Humane Society foster parents Hannah and Jasmine tell the same story a lot of our fosters do: they just want to make a difference. And boy, do they.

The Foster program at KHS is one of the most vital parts of our organization, arranging for the temporary care of more than 1,000 animals last year alone – the animals who need care the most.

"These are the most vulnerable of the animals in our care," says Foster Manager Leora Henry. "Some need just a little extra care, a little extra love, and our amazing foster families provide that for them."

There are three main categories of animals who are sent to live in a foster home:


The Medical Cases – These are the animals who recently received surgery or other medical care and require regular monitoring, like little Dash. The five-week-old kitten needed to have a leg amputated after being caught in the fan belt of a truck. Post-surgery, he was sent to live with a foster family who helped him adjust to life as a "tri-pod." Today, he's thriving, thanks to the care he received.

The Youngsters – When we're caring for animals who are too young to be spayed or neutered and can't yet be adopted out – generally under eight weeks old – foster families step up to the plate. They ensure that they're bottle-fed, or even syringe-fed, and get the care that their mothers would otherwise provide.

The Stressed - Some animals just don't do well in the kennel environment. They begin showing signs of fear and stress and need to take a break. That was the case with Prudence, a tiny three-vear-old terrier mix who refused to even walk on her own and was terrified of being in the kennel areas. After a few weeks of decompressing in a foster home, however, she emerged as a confident some would say overconfident - daredevil of a dog.

And now, there's another category – the result of a crisis that KHS and shelters across the country are facing – **Overcrowding**.

"We have room for about 65 dogs and more than 100 cats," says Henry. "But even with that much space, we're most often stretched to our



limits. Foster families alleviate that problem by welcoming some of these animals into their homes. We simply couldn't help as many animals as we do without our fosters."

That will especially be true this summer, when KHS looks to remodel three of its dog holding areas. The project is being funded by a grant from the ASPCA and generous donations from Lou Ellen and Howard Horwitz, Susan Rausch and Paul Privateer, and the Lenore Hanauer Foundation.

"Twenty-six kennel spaces will be unavailable during the summer months," said Henry. "That's why we're so desperately in need of fosters now. The more homes we can count on as fosters now, the better off we'll all be when summer rolls around."

If you'd like to become a volunteer foster for Kitsap Humane Society, it's easy. You'll participate in a short orientation and online training, and you'll receive outstanding support from our animal care professionals. We also cover all medical procedures, vaccines, medications, and other veterinary care — and if you happen to fall in love with an animal that you've brought into your home, you'll have first dibs at adoption.

"It's an incredibly fulfilling experience," gushes foster Hannah. "We've learned so much along the way, and every animal we've fostered has left a special mark on our hearts."

2024 THE YEAR **IN REVIEW**

f 2023 was the year that all our dreams came true, then 2024 was the year that showed why those were our dreams in the first place.

It began with the Russ and Linda Young Veterinary Lifesaving Center. Completed in September 2023, it's now been in operation for more than a full year and the effect on the community has been literally life-changing. Thanks to the new clinic, we were able to provide more than 30 percent more low-cost community spays and neuters than we did the year before and offer an incredible 3,464 reduced-cost clinic appointments to families in need. But the numbers don't tell the whole story. Our real successes can be found in the relieved, happy tears of the people whose pets were saved when they had nowhere else to turn.

Meanwhile, next door at the Admissions building, we were able to completely renovate our Feline Holding area - thanks to some welltimed awards and grants – while also bringing in more than 4,000 dogs and cats, pigs and goats, birds, rodents, and reptiles.

Just a few yards away, in the Adoption Center, our team found new homes for thousands of animals through adoptions, transfers, and reuniting people with their pets. Foster families provided temporary places of safety for 1,070 critters. And our astounding – and seemingly immune to the smell of puppy poop – Animal Care team provided 84,185 total days of care to the animals we love.

And our Animal Control officers, rescuing animals from Gig Harbor to Bainbridge Island and everywhere in between, conducted 4,520 investigations - a 22 percent increase over the year before.

All of these efforts were led by our new Co-Executive Directors – Jamie Nocula and Dr. Jen Stonequist – who were appointed in the interim in 2023 and named to their new positions in April. Under their leadership and that of our Director of Animal Welfare and her team, we aligned with partners like the Washington Veterans Home, where our country's military retirees are now serving their community by finding great homes for good dogs. We created the "Barks & Rec" program, which allows community members to take animals out for short-term adventures. And we distributed nearly 117,000 pounds of food through our partnership with Greater Good Charities and our friends at Bremerton Foodline.

And while all this was going on, leadership put an emphasis on morale, holding on-campus "Town Halls" and appreciation programs that remind everyone how valued they are. The result? Kitsap Humane Society was named "Best Employer" and "Best Nonprofit Organization" in Kitsap County.

Thank you to everyone – our clients, volunteers, donors, sponsors, staff, and supporters of all kinds - who made 2024 an incredible success. You've made our dreams and the dreams of countless animals come true.

THE BESTEST **BANANA**

t Kitsap Humane Society, we fall in love with every animal who comes through our doors. Some of them, however, somehow leave a bigger mark on our hearts than others. Sometimes it's respect for the battle they've fought to survive. Sometimes it's the way they've grown since they've been with us. Sometimes it's just because they're so darn sweet. With Hannah, it was all three.

This pretty little girl was brought in as a stray by some Good Samaritans in Hansville on Groundhog Day. She had an enormous growth dangling from her side - about the size of a softball - and was skittish and fearful. But, when she was finally brought to KHS, she found her people – people to feed her, to cuddle her, and to try to make her healthy. The growth was surgically removed and sent for testing, while she recovered in a snappy new sweater and was hand-fed balls of food by her good friend and our vet assistant, Bailie.

When the results from the growth came back, however, it was found to be cancerous. At first, our veterinarians thought she might have maybe a year. But then, the cancer had spread to her bladder and was moving fast. She didn't have a year. She might not even have a month. And because the doctors

> wanted to keep close tabs on her quality of life, a hospice foster situation wasn't an option. She was going to stay with us. Her last days were going to be her

> > best days, though.

With suggestions from social media, we created a "bucket list" for Hannah. Thanks to our stellar community, in her final few weeks, she went for countless car rides and wagged her tongue in the wind.

She went for a boat ride with friends and barked at sea lions. She went to the beach and the park with community members and ate ice cream, corned beef, cheese, and even got a Happy Meal from the Golden Arches. She played soccer and got all the pets she wanted. And on March 25, she crossed the Rainbow Bridge with Bailie by her side and surrounded by immeasurable amounts of love.

There were a lot of tears on that Tuesday. Caring for Hannah was challenging, from the surgery that made her more comfortable, to the difficulty in watching her deteriorate. But it was also rewarding. The walks, the smiles, and the joy of watching her be goofy. She gave us more than we could have possibly given her.

On behalf of Hannah and all the sweet animals we care for, we want to thank our staff, our volunteers, and our community for ensuring that all our furry friends get to experience life to the fullest and get all the love they so absolutely deserve. We love you, Hannah Banana.

YOU'VE GOT A FRIEND

ne of the more overlooked consequences of the COVID-19 pandemic is the effect it had on animal welfare. Because people were locked down, so were pets, which meant that many animals weren't spayed or neutered, vaccinated, or microchipped.

"It set animal welfare back 40 years," says KHS Co-Executive Director Jamie Nocula. "It's going to take a lot of time and work to get us back to where we were."


Combine that with the financial insecurity that many families are experiencing, our community is facing an enormous challenge – one that Kitsap Humane Society is already taking on.

Thanks to the completion of the Russ and Linda Young Veterinary Lifesaving Center (VLC) and the growth of our Vet Services team, KHS has been able to expand its services to the community, gain back a little of the ground that was lost, and give a helping hand to those who need it most.

At the end of February 2024 and 2025 – coinciding with World Spay Day – KHS held its first and second low-cost spay and neuter week, during which hundreds of owned and community cats were brought to the clinic. Over five days during each of those events, our veterinarians altered nearly 300 cats for a fraction of the price of what it might cost elsewhere. But that was just the beginning.

In October 2024, we opened our first low-cost vaccine and microchip clinic to the public. Families seeking rabies vaccinations, deworming, and microchip placement for their cats and dogs were able to come to the VLC where their animal was treated at a cost that wouldn't break the bank. Now a monthly offering, more than 250 pets have been the beneficiaries of the service, helping Kitsap County recover from the missed opportunities during the lockdown.

"We've long said that we're 'more than a shelter'," said Nocula. "And we're working to prove that every day. It's not enough to just find homes for these animals we love so much. We need to support those pets and their people after adoption as well. The families of Kitsap need to know that when times get tough and money gets tight, they have a friend they can rely on. We're that friend."







HAPPY TAILS LUNA

n October 2017, ten puppies
were surrendered to Kitsap
Humane Society after the
mom and babies showed health
concerns. It was quickly determined
the entire litter had parvovirus, a
highly contagious and deadly disease.
With the help of KHS staff and a
dedicated foster family, the litter was

nursed back to health and all ten survived. Taking the names of traditional Thanksgiving dishes, the puppies were adopted in November 2017. We're excited to catch up with Gravy, who is now known as Luna!

Living her best life, Luna is now seven years old and still showcasing that puppy energy. From zoomies to cuddles under the blankets and playtime with her human sibling, Luna has brought many laughs and so much love to her family. Joining her humans for their proposal and wedding, and now helping to raise a little one, Luna's family says, "we like to think she taught us how to be parents!"


